



4. Paul said in 1 Corinthians 11:27 that those who eat the bread and drink the cup unworthily are guilty of the body and blood of Yeshua. The word “unworthily” is #371, anaxios meaning irreverently or unworthily. It is from a noun. #370, meaning “unfit.” In what way does this compare to the priest eating the bread of God in Leviticus 21:6? Paul goes on to say that those who eat the bread unworthily have not discerned the LORD’s body. How can discerning the LORD’s body refer to both eating reverently and treating others with respect?

5. Read Luke 20:46-47. How are these scribes jockeying for position?

6. The wedding parable in Matthew 22 says that a man was found at the feast without a wedding garment in verses 11-13. Read Jude 4-15. Compare the man without a wedding garment with the men Jude describe?
