

Discussion Questions for The LORD's Passover Sacrifice

Exodus 12

1. What new insight did you gain by watching this video? How do you respond to this new insight? How will you realign your life based on this new understanding?
2. The peace sacrifice is for Thanksgiving, in fulfillment of a vow, or a voluntary offering (Leviticus 7:11-21). Who can participate in eating the peace sacrifice? Who, then, are the parties in the covenant that is affirmed through the peace sacrifice?
3. God said He would redeem His people with outstretched arm and great judgments in Exodus 6:6. The word "redeemer" is the Hebrew word "ga-al" who is either a kinsman redeemer who pays to buy back a kinsman's property or a kinsman, or a "ga-al is the avenger of blood who renders judgment against a murderer of his kinsman by slaying the murderer. In what way did God "redeem His people from Egypt?" In what way does Yeshua's blood redeem us (1 Peter 1:18)?

4. In Exodus 3:8, God said He had come down to deliver His people from Egypt. In what way did God “come down?”

5. In what way is entering the Tabernacle or the Temple crossing the threshold of God’s dwelling place? In what way is participating in a peace sacrifice or a Passover observance (Exodus 12:41-50) similar to entering the Tabernacle?

6. Zephaniah 1:8 refers to the “day of the LORD’s sacrifice.” How does this chapter about the great day of the LORD refer to the Passover/threshold covenant?
