

## Discussion Questions for “Out of Egypt I Have Called My Son”

1. What new insight did you gain by watching this video? How do you respond to this new insight? How will you realign your life based on this new understanding?
2. Compare Balaam whose story is told in Numbers 23 and 24 with the wise men of Matthew 2. How do both situations demonstrate God’s sovereignty?
3. Applying Jeremiah’s prophecy in Jeremiah 31:15 about Rachel weeping for her children to the death of the children of Bethlehem has been a point that anti-missionaries have used to discredit the New Testament. What is the literal understanding of Jeremiah’s prophecy? Keep in mind that Rachel died long before the time of Jeremiah. How does Rachel weeping for her children apply to Joseph being sold into slavery in Egypt? How does Rachel weeping for her children apply to the death of the children of Bethlehem? How does it also apply to Yeshua’s journey and return from Egypt?
